1. Keri McFarlane Bentley, M.D. ("Licensee") is or has been entitled to be engaged					
in the practice of medicine and surgery in Kansas, having been granted an Active license through

- 3. Licensee's State of Principal License under the IMLC is Tennessee.
- 4. Licensee is or has been entitled to be engaged in the practice of medicine in Kentucky, having been granted a license to practice by the Commonwealth of Kentucky Board of Medical Licensure ("the Kentucky Board") on or about October 19, 2018. This license is valid through February 29, 2024.
- 5. Both the Kentucky Board and the Kansas Board of Healing Arts are "member boards" as defined by Section 2(h) of the IMLC.
- 6. On or about March 24, 2023, the Kentucky Board issued an Emergency Order of Suspension ("the Kentucky Order") that suspended Licensee's license to practice medicine in Kentucky. (Exhibit A the Kentucky Order)

Applicable Law

7. Under K.S.A. 65-28,133, Section 10(d) of the IMLC:

"If a license granted to a physician by a member board is revoked, surrendered or relinquished in lieu of discipline, or suspended, then any license issued to the physician by any other member board shall be suspended, automatically and immediately without further action necessary by the other member boards, for 90 days upon entry of the order by the disciplining board, to permit the member boards to investigate the basis for the action under the medical practice act of that state. A member board may terminate the automatic suspension of the license it issued prior to the completion of the 90-day suspension period in a manner consistent with the medical practice act of that state." [emphasis added]

Conclusions of Law

8. The Board has jurisdiction over Licensee as well as the subject matter of this proceeding, and such proceeding is held in the public interest.

9. Licensee's license to practice medicine, granted by the Kentucky Board, a member board of the IMLC, was suspended on or about March 24, 2023.

10. Under K.S.A. 65-28,133, Section 10(d) of the IMLC, because Licensee's license to practice medicine was suspended by an IMLC member board, the Board must automatically and immediately suspend Licensee's license to practice for 90 days.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Licensee's license to practice medicine and surgery in Kansas is SUSPENDED for a period of 90 days from the date this Order becomes effective as a Final Order.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that upon becoming effective as a Final Order, this document shall be deemed a public record and be reported to any reporting entities authorized to receive such disclosure.
