The Conference Hearing in this matter was held before the Board on December 8, 2023. Hemil H. Maniar, M.D. (“Applicant”) appeared in person, and through counsel Kelli J. Stevens, of Stevens Law, LLC. Lisa Montgomery, Deputy Licensing Counsel, appeared on behalf of the Board. Applicant provided oral argument and written testimony, including exhibits, supporting licensure in this case. Deputy Licensing Counsel provided oral argument and written opposition to Applicant’s licensure in this case. Upon conclusion of the hearing and considering the entire agency record in rendering its decision, the Board determined Applicant meets the technical qualifications for licensure in Kansas. *See* K.S.A. 65-2873; K.A.R. 100-6-2; K.S.A. 65-2833;


