AMENDED SUMMARY ORDER

NOW ON THIS day of Amula 2023, this matter comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board"), this matter comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board"), in summary proceedings pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537.

Under K.S.A. 77-537 and K.S.A. 77-542, this Amended Summary Order shall become effective as a Final Order, without further notice, if no written request for a hearing is made within 15 days of service. Upon review of the agency record and being duly advised in the premises, the following finding of fact, conclusions of law, and order are made by and on behalf of the Board:

Findings of Fact

- Meghan E. Schoenrock, P.T. ("Applicant") was first issued License No. 11-05114
 to practice as a physical therapist in Kansas on June 10, 2015.
- 2. Applicant's last mailing address known to the Board is: CONFIDENTIAL

- 3. Applicant's last known e-mail address provided to the Board is:
 - 4. On December 31, 2021, Applicant's license was cancelled for failure to renew.
- 5. On or about November 14, 2022, Applicant applied to reinstate her license to practice as a physical therapist in Kansas.

Amended Summary Order Meghan E. Schoenrock, P.T. License No: 11-05114 6. From approximately January 1, 2022 to November 3, 2022, Applicant worked as a physical therapist at Power Physical Therapy and Fitness in Junction City, Kansas. (Exhibit 1,

Application for Reinstatement, p.007)

7. For approximately ten (10) months, between January 1, 2022 and November 3, 2022, Applicant practiced as a physical therapist without an active license. During this time, Applicant provided physical therapy services to 21 patients for a total of 52 visits spanning 53 days. (Exhibit 2, Application for Reinstatement, p.009)

Applicable Law

8. K.S.A. 65-2912(a) of the Kansas Physical Therapy Practice Act states in pertinent part:

The board may censure a licensed physical therapist for any of the following grounds:

- (5) unprofessional conduct as defined by rules and regulations adopted by the board
- 9. K.A.R. 100-29-12(a)(18) defines "unprofessional conduct" in pertinent part to include "committing conduct likely to deceive, defraud, or harm the public."

Conclusions of Law

- 10. The Board has jurisdiction over Applicant as well as the subject matter of this proceeding, and such proceeding is held in the public interest.
- 11. The Board finds Applicant violated K.S.A. 65-2912(a) of the Kansas Physical Therapy Practice Act, as defined by K.A.R. 100-29-12(a)(18), by committing conduct likely to deceive, defraud, or harm the public in that Applicant committed an act of unprofessional conduct by practicing as a physical therapist in Kansas without a license for a period of approximately ten (10) months.

12. Based on the facts and circumstances set forth herein, the use of summary

proceedings in this matter is appropriate, in accordance with provisions set forth in K.S.A. 77-

537(a), in that the use of summary proceedings does not violate any provision of law and the

protection of the public interest does not require the Board to give notice and an opportunity to

participate to person other than Applicant.

13. Only the provided Exhibits have been amended in this Amended Summary Order.

The public censure remains unaltered.

IT IS ORDERED that Applicant shall be and is hereby PUBLICLY CENSURED for

violations of the Kansas Physical Therapy Practice Act.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, upon the filing of a Final Order in this matter,

Applicant's application for the reinstatement of her Active license to practice as a physical

therapist in Kansas shall be granted and her license shall be issued.

shall be deemed a public record and be reported to any reporting entities authorized to receive such

disclosure.

Below are responses to the pending questions regarding my reinstatement application.

1. Physical Address for Mailing Address.

2. Work History from 02/05/2022 to Present.

I have reflected on the circumstances that led to my failure to renew my license for 2022, which I learned around November 9, 2022 had been cancelled for failure to renew. I believe that this occurred because of differences in renewal requirements for my Pennsylvania license and my Kansas license. My Pennsylvania license renews every 2 years, while Kansas requires annual renewal but CE every 2 years. My Pennsylvania license has remained active and in good standing at all times and is current. I apologize for the oversight on my Kansas renewal for 2022 and appreciate consideration of my application for reinstatement.

I operate a fitness company, plus a cash-based physical therapy business for some fitness program clients who are in need of PT services. My PT work primarily consists of a very short, 1-3 visit long, plan of care with a high emphasis on home exercises. I have had a couple of clients requiring 7-8 PT visits who started treatment with an injury and then transitioned to a more fitness-focused program, with a few skilled interventions during those visits.

During calendar 2022, my PT encounters involved 21 patients for a total of 53 visits spanning 52 days. I have attached a graph showing this information.

My last date performing any PT services was November 3, 2022. I can assure you that since learning of the oversight in renewing my Kansas license resulting in its cancellation, I have not provided any PT services and instead have directed those patients to different clinicians in the area.

3. Malpractice Coverage.

A Certificate of Insurance reflecting coverage for me individually is attached.
