FINAL ORDER
TERMINATING LICENSE LIMITATIONS

NOW on this 12th day of April 2024, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the request of Jessica A. Craine, P.T. (“Licensee”), for removal of the license limitations contained in the Consent Order filed on August 15, 2022. Licensee appears in person, *pro se*. Matthew Gaus, Deputy Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Respondent, Disciplinary Panel #33 (“DP #33”).

Pursuant to the authority granted to Board by K.S.A. 65-2801 *et seq.*, and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, receiving evidence, and being otherwise advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

1. Licensee is licensed as a physical therapist (P.T.) in the State of Kansas, having been issued License No. 11-04158 on August 5, 2010.

2022 Consent Order

2. On August 15, 2022, a Consent Order was issued establishing the following licensing limitations **CONFIDENTIAL** ::

No Access to Prescription Medication

8. On February 1, 2024, Licensee filed a Motion to Terminate Limitations imposed in the 2022 Consent Order.

9. On March 13, 2024, DP #33 filed a neutral Response to Motion for Termination of Limitations.

Compliance with 2022 Consent Order

16. DP #33 has produced no evidence Licensee has violated any limitations listed in the 2022 Consent Order.

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19. The Board finds that Licensee has been compliant with the 2022 Consent Order.

20. The Board finds that the Licensee has met the following requirements for

termination of the limitations in the 2022 Consent Order:

a. 20 months have expired since the execution of the August 15, 2022, Consent Order.

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Conclusions of Law

K.S.A. 65-2801 states the purpose of the Board and the healing arts act is to properly protect the public against unprofessional, improper, unauthorized, and unqualified practice of the healing arts and from unprofessional conduct by persons licensed to practice under this act.

K.S.A. 65-2836 provides that a licensee's license may be revoked, suspended, or limited, or the licensee may be publicly censured or placed under probationary conditions if the licensee has violated any of the 31 provisions listed in the statute.

K.S.A. 65-2912 states that the Board may suspend or revoke the license of any licensed physical therapist, may limit the license any licensed physical therapist, or may censure a licensed physical therapist for any of the nine grounds listed in the statute.

Order

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, by the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts that the license limitations imposed by the August 15, 2022, Consent Order are hereby **TERMINATED** and that Licensee shall have no further obligations for compliance with said order. The effective date of this Final Order is **April 12, 2024**.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a Final Order. A Final Order is effective upon service, and service of a Final Order is complete upon mailing. Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529, Licensee may petition the Board for Reconsideration of a Final Order within fifteen (15) days following service of the final order. Additionally, a party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a Final Order by filing a petition in the District Court, as authorized by K.S.A. 77-601, *et seq.* Reconsideration of a Final Order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within **30 days** following service of the Final Order. 
