**JOURNAL ENTRY GRANTING
EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY PA LICENSE**

On April 12, 2024, the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) conducted a conference hearing on the application for extension of a temporary physician assistant license (“Extension”) filed by Tyler Henness, P.A. Matthew Gaus, Deputy Litigation Counsel, appeared in person as counsel for DP No. 39. Tyler Henness, P.A. (“Licensee”), appeared in person, *pro se*.

1. On or about September 22, 2023, Licensee was granted a temporary license to practice as a P.A. in Kansas (License No. T-06057) under the provisions of K.S.A. 65-28a07.
2. On February 19, 2024, Licensee sent an email to the Board's licensing department requesting an extension of his temporary license. Licensee requests an extension of six months.
3. Licensee is scheduled to sit for the Physician Assistant National Certifying Exam (“PANCE”) on April 29, 2024
4. On March 22, 2024, Licensee's temporary P.A. license expired at the end of the 6-month period authorized by statute.


5. On or about March 26, 2024, DP #39 filed a Motion for Conference Hearing. DP #39's motion stated a neutral response to Mr. Henness's request for extension but supported a hearing on his request at the earliest possible date.
6. K.S.A. 65-28a07 provides that:
 - (a) The board shall provide for the temporary licensure of any physician assistant who has made proper application for licensure, has the required qualifications for licensure, except for examination, and has paid the prescribed license fee. Such temporary license shall authorize the person so licensed to provide patient services within the limits of the temporary license.
 - (b) A temporary license is valid: (1) For six months from the date of issuance; or (2) until the board makes a final determination on the applicant's request for licensure. The board may extend a temporary license, upon a majority vote of the members of the board, for a period not to exceed one year.

Upon review of Licensee's request for extension of his temporary Kansas P.A. license, the agency record, the applicable statutes and regulations, and the statements by the parties at hearing, the Board approves Licensee's request as follows:

Licensee's temporary Kansas P.A. license is extended from March 22, 2024, for a period of six months.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Licensee's request for extension of his temporary Kansas P.A. license is **GRANTED** as stated above. The effective date of this Journal Entry is April 12, 2024.


