## FINAL ORDER TERMINATING CONSENT ORDER

NOW on this 17th day of January, 2013, comes before the Presiding Officer, Ray N. Conley, D.C., the request of Benjamin Henning, D.C. ("Licensee") for termination of the Consent Order filed in this matter on June 14, 2012. In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501, et seq., and upon due consideration of the agency record and applicable statutes, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Presiding Officeer makes the following determinations:

- 1. Licensee is licensed to practice chiropractic in the State of Kansas, having been issued License No. 01-05490 on approximately June 22, 2012.
- 2. On or about June 4, 2012, Licensee entered into a Consent Order with the Board as a condition to being granted a license to chiropractic in the State of Kansas, due to the length of time Licensee had been absent from the active practice of chiropractic. The Consent Order was filed with the Board on June 14, 2012.
- 3. Under the terms of the Consent Order, Licensee agreed to have his practice of chiropractic supervised and monitored by another Kansas-licensed chiropractor who was approved by the Board. Additionally, quarterly reports of the supervision and monitoring were required to be submitted to the Board.
- 4. Board staff received all required reports and such reports indicated that Licensee was in full compliance throughout the reporting timeframe.

5. On or about November 14, 2012, Licensee requested termination of his Consent Order.

6. On December 28, 2012, the Respondent Board filed a Response to Licensee's

request in support of termination.

7. The Presiding Officer finds that Licensee has demonstrated full compliance and

satisfaction with the requirements of the Consent Order and that termination is warranted in the

circumstances.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF

HEALING ARTS that the Consent Order filed June 14, 2012, in this matter is hereby

TERMINATED and Licensee shall have no further obligation for compliance.

Reconsideration of a Final Order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within 30 days following service of the Final Order.
