FINAL ORDER

NOW, on this <u>17</u> day of March 2009, the above-entitled matter comes on before Jack Confer, Executive Director of the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts. After reviewing the file and being duly advised in the premises, the Executive Director makes the following determinations.

- 1. On February 9, 2009, the Executive Director, on behalf of the Board, issued a Summary Order regarding the license of Terry Lynn Mills (Licensee), LRT. The Summary Order required licensee to provide documentation of completion of at least 12 hours of continuing education hours within 15 days of receipt of Summary Order and payment of a \$250 fine.
- 2. The Summary Order contained a notice that a written request for hearing could be filed within 15 days following service, but if no hearing is requested, the Summary Order would become effective as a final order of the Board upon expiration of the time for requesting a hearing.
- 3. No hearing has been requested by any party and, therefore, the Summary Order became effective on March 3, 2009.
- 4. Licensee submitted the required proof of continuing education to the board as required by the Summary Order on February 11, 2009.

5. The Licensee has requested a payment plan for the fine which provides for payment of \$50 payable March 6, 2009 and monthly payments of \$50 the first Friday

of each month thereafter.

6. The Executive Director determines that the payment plan is reasonable

and is approved. All payments should be made payable to the Kansas State Board of

Healing Arts and sent to the attention of the Licensing Audit Coordinator at the Board

office address.

SUMMARY ORDER

NOW ON THIS That day of February, 2009, this matter comes before Jack Confer, Executive Director, Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board"), in summary proceedings pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537.

After reviewing the agency record and being duly advised in the premises, the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and order are made for and on behalf of the Board:

- 1. Terry Mills, LRT ("Licensee") was originally issued license number 22-01497 to practice as a Radiologic Technologist in the State of Kansas on October 30, 2005.
- 2. On or about September 3, 2008, Licensee submitted an application for renewal of their license.
- 3. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-7307 and K.A.R. 100-73-7 each Licensee desiring to renew a Radiologic Technologist license must have completed at least 12 credits of continuing education and to provide proof of completion to the Board upon request
- 4. As part of the renewal process, Licensee certified that the rules regarding continuing education had been read, that compliance had been achieved, and that documentation of the continuing education would be maintained for a three-year period and produced to the Board upon request.

- 5. Licensee was randomly selected to provide verification of compliance with the continuing requirements and on November 14, 2008, a letter was mailed to Licensee requesting that Licensee provide no later than December 31, 2008, the records relied upon when Licensee certified achievement of the required continuing education.
- 6. Licensee has failed to provide documented evidence of continuing education by the due date.
- 7. By failing to provide documented evidence of continuing education, Licensee has violated K.S.A. 65-7307(c), failing to provide evidence of satisfactory completion of 12 hours of continuing education.
- 8. In addition to any other penalty prescribed under the Radiologic Technologist Practice Act, K.S.A. 65-7313 and K.S.A. 65-2836a authorizes the Board to assess an administrative fine in an amount not exceeding \$5,000 for the first violation of the Radiologic Technologist Practice Act.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED Licensee is hereby fined \$250 for failure to respond to the Board's legal request for information. The fine is due within thirty days of the effective date of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that licensee shall submit proof of the continuing education requirements for the previous year to the Board with fifteen days following service of this summary order.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a summary order. A party to whom a summary order is issued may file a written request for a hearing within 15 days following service of the summary order. If a hearing is not requested, the summary order shall become effective as a final order of the Board upon expiration of the time for requesting a hearing. A request for a
