FINAL ORDER TERMINATING MONITORING REQUIREMENTS

NOW, on this 7th day of December 2012, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") the request of Brian Sewell, R.T. ("Licensee") for termination of the monitoring requirements contained within the Consent Order previously entered in this matter. Licensee appears in person and *pro se*. Stacy R. Bond, Associate Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Petitioner Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Respiratory Therapy Practice Act, K.S.A. 65-5501, *et seq.*, and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501, *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order following a conference hearing in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, hearing the testimony and arguments of the parties, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

- 1. Brian Sewell, R.T. ("Licensee") is licensed to practice respiratory therapy in the State of Kansas, having been issued License No. 16-03488 on approximately May 24, 2007.
- 2. On or about December 7, 2011, Licensee entered into a Consent Order with the Board based upon information disclosed upon renewal of his license regarding criminal convictions Confidential

4. The monitoring provisions of the Consent Order are not self-terminating, but allow Licensee to request the Board for termination upon successful completion of a three (3) year period of compliance.

8. The Board finds that Licensee has demonstrated satisfactory compliance with Confidential to-date and that based upon the particular circumstances of Licensee, early termination should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS that Licensee's request to terminate the monitoring requirements contained in the Consent Order is hereby granted.
