- B. Continuing Education In-Person Waiver Extended to December 31, 2024. Ms. Gile requested input from Council regarding whether or not the yearly waiver for in-person CEUs affects the ND profession. General discussion with result being waiver doesn't impact NDs.
- C. Criteria for educational programs. Discussion regarding 160-hour ND continuing education curriculum from K-State. There is concern that this 160-hour program may be proposed as a substitute for the current Kansas

ND education requirement of a four-year full-time resident program of academic and clinical study. If applicants for Kansas ND license have a current ND license from another state, the Board may waive the education requirement if the Board finds that the other state's standards for licensure are equivalent to the standards for a ND license in Kansas.
